They probably wanted to be jet fighter pilots . the work isn't as exciting as people think . You don' see the world , just the insides of airports . There isn't much job security either . There are lots of ways you could lose your job . It suits me at the moment because I'm young and single , but wouldn't want to be still doing it in ten years' time .

TV and theatre actor , Jane Nicholson : There's nothing I'd rather do . The feeling you get is like nothing else , and it outweighs the many negatives , like the pressure , the stage fright and the long periods without work . Unless you're a big star , you never know where the next job is going to come from .

Pianist and singer , Amina Kureishi : Almost anyone can become a musician , but the trick is to make a living from it . I meant , there are singers , there are good singers and there are successful singers , but they're three different things .

For most of us it's a life of late rights , long hours practicing and travelling from place to places , being paid just enough to put food on the table . The majority of professional musicians need other incomes , usually from teaching .

Charity worker , Ben Harper : I can understand why this work comes so high in the list . It's the job satisfaction , isn't it ? A lot of people probably feel they'd rather do something to help others than work for a company making money for someone else .

But the thing is that for most charity workers. It's just an office job . Even non- profit organizations have to be run like businesses these days . The people at the top are paid well , but those lower down are often volunteers .

A number of airports in the Middle East have started implementing the ban on taking laptop computers into the airplane cabin on flights to the USA and the UK. A new directive from the USA and UK now requires electronic devices larger than a smartphone to be checked in to be stored in the hold of the aircraft. The US ban has affected airlines from eight Middle Eastern countries, while similar UK restrictions apply to six countries. Officials said the reason for the ban was that larger digital devices could contain explosives. **They** did not give any indication as to how long the ban would be in place. However, the Dubai-based Emirates airlines said it had received instructions to enforce it until at least October There has been mixed reaction to the ban. Airlines were unhappy about 14. There has been mixed reaction to the ban. Airline were unhappy about being given just 96 hours to comply with it or risk losing their license to fly into the USA. They are unsure whether or not to pass the financial burden of the additional step of security checks onto passengers. Some of the affected countries are questioning why the ban affects only Muslim-majority countries. Passengers, meanwhile, seem to accept it. Rakan Mohammed from Qatar said: "It's a rule. I follow the rules. The bigger problem for **my family** is the no smoking." Maryam Hassad from Dubai was more concerned about how to keep her children occupied on a long flight without their laptops.
